First to receive the "New Model Development Support Award" from Cummins Inc.

In December 2021, Daido Metal U.S.A. Inc., a consolidated subsidiary, was awarded the "New Product Development Support Award" for the first time by Cummins Inc. as an outstanding supplier in the 2021 Cummins Supplier Recognition Awards.



Daido Metal U.S.A. Inc., Indiana Sales and Engineering Office was instrumental in securing the new business from Cummins. The Indiana office was established in August, 2017 to strengthen local sales promotion and technical support for strategic customers such as Cummins Inc.

Among the increasing number of new development projects, the entry of plain bearings for light truck diesel engines was launched in 2021 by Daido Metal U.S.A. Inc. receiving an order for a product (half bearing), in which surface treatment technology was applied to lead-free materials with improved abrasion and seizure resistance.



This product was the first to be produced locally at the Mexico Plant (Daido Metal Mexico S.A. de C.V., a consolidated subsidiary.), and received this award for its high quality, speedy response and contribution to improving the local procurement rate as well.





Encouraged by this award, our group will continue to work closely with Cummins to further enhance the performance of diesel engines.
